**2019 NYSAFLT Annual Conference**  
November 1–2, in Saratoga Springs, N.Y.

- Applicants must be current members of NYSAFLT (If you are not currently a member, you may join now, however preference will be given to those applicants who were members prior to applying.)
- Each **new teacher scholarship** covers the full registration for Friday and Saturday attendance., including a pre-conference workshop. Travel, hotel, and meals other than those included in the conference program *are not included*.
- Each **mentor teacher partial scholarship** includes a \$50 stipend toward registration fees.
- New teacher applicants must be new teachers (1-5 years experience), currently teaching in a school in New York State. Mentor teacher applicants must have seven or more years of experience and must have attended at least one NYSAFLT Annual Conference in the past three years.
- Applicants must agree to attend the entire conference, including a focus-group breakfast Friday, November 1, 7:30–8:15 a.m. and a final debrief session on Saturday afternoon, time tbd.
- Each scholarship winner will be assigned a conference mentor with whom you will meet at different times over the course of the conference.
- The application deadline is Friday, September 20. All applications and letters of support must be received by this date. Applicants will be notified by September 30.
- To apply for a scholarship, please follow the link below. You will be asked to upload a letter from your immediate supervisor to provide confirmation of your employment, a brief comment of support, and confirmation that you will be allowed release time to attend the conference. - Scholarship recipients who do not fulfill the requirements of the scholarship (attending the full conference, breakfast Friday, and the debrief session) may be charged full conference attendance rates.
